Super Sunday

Going Forward: Joshua 3:9-17

The nation of Israel stood at the edge of the Jordan River getting ready to cross to go into the land there and there had to be a lot of questions: How does this work? Is it dangerous? Do we have to do this?

Without all those answers they went forward and the rest as they say, “is history”.

What we will learn from their experience will be essential for your life as Jesus follower and the life of The Orchard. You will hear the heart of our Elder Leadership Team, learn what they do and how this is contributing to your life and The Orchard.

This will be a special vision Sunday and how we are “Going Forward”.

These 5X5 verses apply to next weeks’ sermon. Study with these verses before next Sunday and then bring your insights from your study .

5X5 Daily Bible Readings

- Day 1: Genesis 12:1-8
- Day 2 Matthew 24:14-30
- Day 3: Ephesians 5:15-17
- Day 4: 2 Kings 7:3-11
- Day 5: Hebrews 11:1-40 (memorize 11:6)

Growth Group Questions and Discussions

Let’s talk Super Bowl: go around & talk about where you were, how you feel about the outcome, & how little/much it all meant to you.

In your lifetime, what has been your favorite sporting moment? (ANY sport: personal or team)

As a group, recap Charley’s sermon; thoughts, reflections, etc.

READ Joshua 3:9-17 Discuss what is going on in the passage.

As per Charley’s sermon; what is the difference between Pioneers and Settlers? Which would you say you fall more naturally into? When was a time you were a Pioneer?

Joshua 3:14-15 What do you think the emotions were of the people involved? What was the difference between those in the front and those in the very back? When it comes to risk taking, where in the line do you usually find yourself?

God has some Jordan’s for you to cross and His power is waiting to be released when you take some risks. That said, where in your life do you need to get your feet wet? (Where do you need to step out in faith and risk?)

As a church body, where does The Orchard need to get our feet wet?
Take some time for prayer requests but have each member prayed over that they would step out and risk this week and get their feet wet. Expect each person to come back next week with a report on how it went.
