Proverbs 26

The first 12 verses deal severely with foolish behavior and it's not pretty. Like verse 8, "Honoring a fool is like shooting yourself in the foot." DSV. Now, 3000 years later we buy magazines and watch TV shows to marvel at the foolish behavior of celebrities! You hardly ever hear anyone talk about valuing wisdom or see a wise person honored. What happened? How can we restore Godly wisdom to it's rightful and powerful place in our own lives while living in a society that values foolish behavior? Danger: If you go with the flow, a fool you'll be!

Use the SOAP method of Bible Study with these verses before next Sunday for insights into next Sunday's Message:

Scripture - Ask the lord to lead you to the specific part of the scripture that is for this time; often it will be a phrase, single verse or several verse.

Observation - What are you seeing in these specific verses - make all the observation you can about what the verses say and mean.

Application - Ask the Lord to show you how these verses apply to today's world, our community, our church your life in general and today in particular.

Prayer - Turn your scripture, observations and application insights into a prayer asking God to specifically bring about this word into your life today.

Growth Group Questions and Discussions

What are some pieces of wisdom you learned growing up from parents or trusted mentors that have stuck with you? Any advice you received as a young person that ended up being unwise?

If you could pass on one piece of wisdom to the next generation, what would it be?

We're SOAPing again, so pull out your Bibles. Challenge your group to SOAP during the week and exchange emails/texts for accountability if it helps. But let's become people who learn from God's Word. For any who haven't been present, someone explain SOAP to the group.

Tonight's Growth Group: Whichever day you are meeting on, read the chapter of Proverbs for that date. Split up individually and read the chapter and each person SOAP what verse stands out the most. Take some time as a group to allow people to read over their Scripture passage and SOAP it.

Come back together and as a group, go around and discuss what you learned.
