Promised Land Parameters

(Joshua 5 - 6:2)

What’s new about the Promised land? After years of waiting and circling around in the wilderness, God moved the Israelites into the Promised Land. But before they could move forward, they needed to know some “rules of engagement”. Through this, we will learn some very necessary understanding so that we can move forward in the new and fresh challenges that God has for us.

Growth Group Questions

Share a story about when you tried some new endeavor or went on some adventure that was a challenge for you? Did you succeed or fail? What was the big thing you learned from it? Can you describe what it felt like after a long time and you had the sense that you were coming into a new and fresh season?

What are some things that stood out to you from the sermon?

What are some ways that you can think of how things changed for the Israelites moving from the wilderness to the Promised Land?

Read Joshua 5:1-10. Why is the covenant of circumcision initiated on the Promised Land side of the Jordan crossing? What was the importance of the covenant in the conquest of the Promised Land?

Read Joshua 5:13-15. What are the implications of the general of the Lord saying that he wasn't on Joshua's side or the enemies side? How do we get to be on God's side?

Read Joshua 3:15 & 5:11-12 Describe what it must have been like at first to have this first meal? What do you think was most difficult for the Israelites to adjust to as they moved forward with the new way God is providing in the Promised Land? What would be an example of the change of provision from God in your own life?

What are ways that God calls us to stand on our own so we can move forward in our lives?

Read Joshua 6:2 Why do you think God showed this to Joshua? If you saw things in advance what would that do for your confidence? Do you think God still shows people things ahead of time? How does that work and where did God show Joshua that Jericho had already been defeated? When Joshua sees Jericho already defeated what do you think happened in his heart?

Has there been a Promised Land conquest in your life and you haven't taken hold of all that God had for you? What happened and why?

Identify what would be a Promised Land change in your life right now?
