

Growth Group Questions:

Somewhere between no pony for your birthday and the loss of someone, what was one of the greatest disappointments you remember from your childhood?

What are some ways that people deal with disappointments in life? What are some of the lingering consequences of disappointment in our lives?

Charley made the statement, "Jesus never fails but He does disappoint." What do you make of that statement and do you think this is true? Can you think of some people in the Bible whom Jesus disappointed? How have you seen this in your life?

Charley talked about the "awkward prayer time" when you're alone - what did he mean by this and have you experienced it?

READ Luke 24:13-29 What general observations do you make about this unique section of Scripture? We have the privilege of knowing the ending but describe what real time emotions these two disciples must have been going through during this passage. Why do you think Jesus showed up for these two guys? Why do you think Jesus is interacting with them in this way?

READ Mark 14:32-42 Describe Jesus' emotional situation and condition. Describe what you see in this that would be disappointing for Him?

READ Luke 24:30-35 Why do you think Jesus finally revealed Himself in this way at this time? Have you ever had a moment in Communion where you felt like you saw Jesus more clearly? What does Communion and all it symbolize teach us about our personal disappointment?
